



## Flagstaff Sustainable Living Fair

**The Flagstaff Sustainable Living Fair is a grassroots event focused on community education and fun**, an outreach to people of all ages, interests and backgrounds. Renewable energy and sustainable development are crucial for the future of life on earth as we know it, and we want the Fair to be a resource for people to learn more about how they can incorporate sustainability into their lifestyles and personal choices.

**The Fair will be the weekend of June 16<sup>th</sup> and 17<sup>th</sup>** at Fort Tuthill Park in Flagstaff. This is an opportunity for you to share your knowledge, experience, products and services to people living in northern Arizona interested in a sustainable lifestyle. You have the opportunity to contribute to the Flagstaff Sustainable Living Fair as a **sponsor**, an **exhibitor**, or simply as an **individual** wanting to share or volunteer your expertise. There will be sponsorship publicity, covered and uncovered information booths, seminar rooms and workshop/demonstration areas available; you can choose one or more ways to participate and be a partner in the Fair.

It is our intent that the awareness, understanding, and skills that are developed through attendance at the Fair will lead to our communities reducing the trend of resource depletion and increasing their activities related to replenishing, reusing, and recycling valuable resources.

This is a completely grass-roots, educational event focused on Northern and Central Arizona. We are deliberately seeking support only from **local** individuals, companies, not-for-profit organizations, educational institutions, and local government; large, multi-regional companies are not being asked to participate. All sponsors and exhibitors are strongly encouraged to provide educational materials, exhibits, workshops or lectures to educate the public about the smarter choices, product selections and activities they can make that will foster a more sustainable community.

The Fair will be a carbon-neutral, waste-free event, and we want to be sure we "walk our talk". In order to make the Fair available to everyone interested in attending there will be no entrance fee. However, there will be a carbon-fee charged to anyone driving a conventionally-fueled vehicle to the Fair for parking -- the fee will be tied to the cost of planting trees to offset the vehicle emissions. Anyone who rides their bike, walks, takes the bus from central Flagstaff, or drives an alternative fueled vehicle to the Fair will not have to pay the carbon-fee.
